

JIGGS COZ led early and rated kindly as he set the pace, was pressured on the backstretch, quickened on the far turn then held sway under a hand ride. TRUE METROPOLITAN was under severe restraint early, swung from the rail to three-wide late on the first turn and moved up outside the leader to force the issue on the backstretch, chased on the far turn and was all out through the stretch but hung. TORQUAY, rated early, was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, began to close, was roused late turn and gained contention, then rallied gamely. BOND FIRE stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail on the far turn but evened out in the stretch.
