Footnotes

D' WILD STORM dueled on the backstretch, gained a short lead early turn then widened through the stretch and finished under a hand ride. QUINZEE raced midpack, moved seven-wide into the turn, closed steadily, raced five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. COOK'S LOOK, in touch between horses, was hustled four-wide-wide late turn then finished gamely and got up late for third. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM, in touch, saved ground, chased into the stretch and finished gamely in vain. NORTHOFFIFTY, in touch early, raced five-wide on the turn, dropped back a bit early turn, was hustled into the stretch but failed to threaten. JASAMINE COT, in touch, was hustled four-wide on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. TRAJECTORY LINE stalked the pace, raced three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. JAZ RYDER raced midpack along the rail then two-deep late turn, chased into the stretch but did not threaten. NORTHERN STORE settled well off the early pace, angled from the third to sixth path on the turn but did not threaten.

KISS' LEGACY dueled, was headed at the turn, forced the issue then chased hard into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. CLASSIC PORT raced midpack between rivals, was hustled four-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. LOVER'S LAKE, off a step slowly, closed up quickly, raced six-wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. TWICE WILD bid along the rail midway of the backstretch, gave way a little at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. HOLD CARD raced off the pace, saved ground but was never a factor.
