**Footnotes**

MARKED UP, well back early, closed quickly on the far turn, led late turn but was headed at the top of the stretch, dug in and got up late under a drive. FIONN stalked the pace, took command midturn, was headed but rebid inside at the top of the stretch, gained command but gave way grudgingly in deep

stretch. HE'S ALL THAT raced well back, closed outside rivals on the far turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. BLIZZARD BLISS, off a step slowly, circled on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. KINNAIRD raced well back, cut from the third path to the rail closing late turn but failed to menace. WATER MOCCASIN, well back early, closed into the far turn and quickly gained contention, chased to the stretch then evened out. GOODBYE POPPA raced off the pace, angled four to six-wide on the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. HUSH'S THUNDER CAT raced midpack, was hustled six-wide late turn then tired in the final furlong. I'M THE MANAGER, well back early, was hustled along the rail late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. KNIGHTSWOOD raced in the middle of the pack until the far turn, faded and offered no late response. B SHARP pressed the pace, bid early turn, vied briefly, was headed midturn and tired. MANDERLAY led early, set a reserved pace, was joined early turn, was headed by another midturn, chased to the stretch and tired. HONG KONG TIGER raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a rally.
