Footnotes

RILEY RIPASSO raced midpack, angled five-wide late turn, rallied and was just up in time, driving. KARA'S ORIENTATION set a reserved pace along the rail, was all out in the stretch but just failed to hold. RIVER LEMON raced off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide late turn, cut back to the rail a furlong out and finished determinedly. MIDDLE OF THE NITE bobbled at the start, stalked two and three-wide, chased into the stretch then evened out in the final 16th. MACALLAN raced off the pace, angled three to five-wide through the turn, was roused upper stretch and finished gamely but was not a threat. SMART SKY, off slowly, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. PETER'S CHARISMA raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. EL SOMBRE, well back early, raced along the rail and two-wide then evened out in the stretch. SKY TIGER raced in midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch but had no stretch response. MAJOR BRAVO pulled early and stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and tired. GRESHAM PALACE had brief speed, was headed and settled midpack then faded late turn.
