Footnotes

HOLY SCHNEIKIES raced in the second flight, closed late backstretch, forced the pace on the far turn, bid late turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed with a strong late effort. RAGING STAR also closed nearing the far turn and forced the pace, bid late turn, dueled through the stretch but was outfinished. MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG, off slowly then rated well back, closed on the backstretch, angled three to six-wide through the turn then finished determinedly. SEPTEMBER SQUARE raced off the pace, closed on the far turn, chased five-wide into the stretch, was game but offered no bid. ACTIVE DUTY raced midpack, was contentious on the far turn and stalked to the stretch but evened out in the late stages. FUNFAHA, well back early, angled five-wide late turn but never reached contention. SOUL BLUES raced off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. COFFEE BREAK, well back early, angled out late turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then lacked a rally. LOOKS PURRRFECT closed late backstretch, was roused late turn and was all out along the rail in the stretch but flattened out. BURANO led quickly and took a long lead, was pressured on the far turn, dueled into the stretch and tired. SPRING RIDGE broke in the air, raced well back, angled out six-wide late turn but was never a threat. CUVARA broke outward, closed late backstretch, was in range through the turn but tired in the stretch.
