Footnotes

SIBONET settled off the pace, closed on the rail late turn, rallied along the wood through the stretch, took command in the final 16th, finishing under a hand ride. WILL TO SHINE led quickly, set a reserved pace, was all out through the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. COOKING SCHOOL raced in midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch and launched a determined drive between rivals. STREET PRIZE stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. TAPIA raced off the pace, saved ground, angled out at the top of the stretch and finished gamely in vain. ARCHAGONNAKISSME stalked the pace, moved off the rail midturn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. STUNNING IN RED settled off the pace, was hustled from midpack on the turn then evened out midstretch. KATIE IT'S FINE raced in midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. GINGER MINT raced off the pace, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn but never reached contention. WHISPERING WALL broke outward, settled off the pace, closed two and three-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. CHARISMATICALLY, in midpack early, settled off the pace, chased four-wide late turn but lacked a rally. WOODBINE KITTEN raced off the pace, trailed through the turn then lacked a closing response. IMPROVISING ducked out shortly after leaving the gate, raced off the pace and lacked a rally. CROATIAN DIVA, in touch early, was hustled on the turn then tired upper stretch.
