Footnotes

NOBLE CHIEF set a pressured pace, shook clear into the stretch, widened when asked and finished under a hand ride. MALIBU TIDE, in range between rivals, chased three-wide into the stretch, angled out and finished gamely. GRAND ARCH stalked four-wide, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. BIALYSTOK, rated in range along the rail, finished gamely between foes. ONETWOPUNCH forced the pace, stalked from the rail on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. GOOD ANSWER raced in midpack from the outside, came four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. STREET FIGHT stalked the pace in hand, closed up and forced the issue on the turn then evened out midstretch. SOUTH OF DIXIE forced the pace, dropped back at the turn, was hustled from midpack then flattened out in deep stretch. RESPONSIVE EYE raced off the pace, was checked between rivals early turn then lacked a rally. MASTER NOBLE raced in midpack between rivals and never reached contention. MARSDEN raced off the pace, was

hustled five-wide late turn but failed to menace. VACATION TIME, off slowly, raced well back along the rail, was all out in the stretch but did not threaten. MANION, off slowly, raced well back, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response. TURF LAW raced off the pace and lacked a closing response.
