HUNTERS BAY stalked the pace in hand, closed up and forced the new leader's efforts on the far turn, challenged in earnest upper stretch, dueled to the final 16th and drove clear. PENDER HARBOUR pressed the pace and was also in hand, forced the issue through the backstretch and took the lead entering the turn, was pressured and finally joined upper stretch, dueled gamely but yielded grudgingly in the final 16th. STATELY VICTOR, in touch early, chased from off the pace on the far turn, finished gamely but did not menace. MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG, rated early, was hustled on the far turn then tired in the stretch. STRAIGHT STORY led early under strong restraint, set a pressured pace, was headed at the far turn, chased hard on the turn but began to give way, bobbled in deep stretch and was pulled up and vanned off.
