Footnotes

HIGHLAND HONEY stalked the pace four wide, rallied, gained command at the sixteenth pole and drew out, pulled up lame and was vanned off. HARRIKANAW came through inside to gain a clear lead at the nine sixteenths pole, gave way late to be second best. SOCIAL KNIGHT had speed to gain a clear lead early, chased from off the rail, held her position in the stretch. SUGAR KICK trailed, rallied late five wide. STEPHANIE'S WAGER was three wide and gained mildly. REASON FOR JUSTICE bobbled at the start, was three wide, and not a threat. AUGURI SHARDAE stalked the pace from inside, came left handed urging on the turn, and dropped back. TOUGH RAMBLER stalked the pace from off the rail, and weakened. SHARK ATTACK stalked the pace three wide, and tired. LAYOVER was four wide, and not a factor. DEMONOUSLY DANCED raced inside, and faded.
