BELLA MOSELLA raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn, bid upper stretch and drove clear. CHERRY GROVE, unhurried early on the rail, was still in hand late turn, moved three-deep at the top of the stretch, angled out further then rallied smartly. ELEGANT EFFORT stalked three-wide, chased the leader into the stretch, bid upper stretch but was outfinished. SWANKY BUBBLES raced midpack, was hustled between foes late turn and finished determinedly. MEY INDEED stalked the pace, was hustled between foes late turn then flattened out late. SIGN OF HONOR raced off the pace, gained four-wide late turn,

was forced out to the sixth path to get around the fading G T'S GOT A TEMPER late turn then hung in the stretch. NODAGAIN BLONDIE raced three-deep midpack and lacked the necessary closing response. ALWAYS HOPE led quickly, set the pace, weakened stubbornly upper stretch then tired. REGENT LIGHT, always well back, raced on the third path, lacked a rally. J J'S CREEK stalked from the second-path, was hustled late turn then tired in the stretch. SEDONAS CREEK, always well back, raced five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. EPIC PROPORTION raced off the pace along the second path and lacked a closing response. LOULA, in touch early, steadied in traffic midturn then faded along the rail. G T'S GOT A TEMPER pressed the pacesetter three-wide, gave way late turn, faded to the outside and pulled up at the head of the stretch.
