Footnotes

FAR AND NEAR stalked the pace, took command at the 1/2 mile pole and drew off then held sway under a hand ride. T C MAIDEN was unhurried early, closed late backstretch, chased on the turn and could not gain in the stretch. WILA WEST, well back early, closed three-wide late turn, failed to threaten and was best of the rest. JANE B. A. trailed early, was hustled from early on the far turn and never reached contention. ORIENTAL DOLL, in touch on the backstretch, raced four-wide on the far turn then evened out. ENERGY RUSH led quickly, set the pace, was headed at the 1/2 mile pole then faded along the rail through the turn. SPICE IS NICE bobbled at the start, stalked the pace, but gave way midturn and faded.
