CAUSE AND EFFECT broke alertly, was headed and forced the pace, regained the lead early turn, was roused upper stretch and widened then was taken in hand. JAMMIN IN THE SAND stalked three-wide, was roused late turn, held second but could not stay close to the leader. DAKOTA FREEWAY, in touch early, was hustled along the rail through the turn and evened out in the stretch. LOOK ALIVE stalked from between horses, was checked hard early turn to avoid a falling horse then never regained momentum. GARZON, in touch, veered out early turn, raced four-wide and did not threaten. TWO FACE FLYER was in touch early, veered four-wide early turn to avoid the spill, angled in from midturn but lacked a rally. LUNA CANYON vied early, took a short lead, was headed early turn, broke down and fell. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE SPILL LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
