IN RITA'S HONOR led quickly, set the pace, turned back rivals when challenged at the 1/4 pole, drove clear then held under a drive. ALAYA, always in touch, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and finished gamely. ARCHERESS stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn and finished gamely. STREETWISE pressed the pace two-deep, bid upper stretch, failed to get by and weakened late. FOXS CONSORT stalked from the rail, bid two-deep upper stretch, vied briefly, chased, then flattened out late. RIVER NORE, in touch two-deep, lacked a rally. ARZU steadied at the start and again entering the turn along the rail, moved to the second path but lacked a rally. WEST GRAND raced off the pace, lacked a rally.
