PRIZED HUMOUR had inside speed to take a slim lead, held it into and through the turn, was pressured by rival into the final furlong then kept to task to the wire. PERFECT CHEROKEE stalked while inside of foes, then bid between entering the stretch, took on the winner and chased that one to the winner in a solid try. HOLY KNIGHT saved ground in an off the pace run then angled off the rail in the drive and was up for the show. KINGS VILLAGE pressed the pace and was a factor on the far turn then outfinished in the drive. EMPIRE RISING veered out at the break, kept contact with the leaders while between foes into the far turn then lacked a finish. GIGANTOS off the pace and outside early, bid wide on the far turn, was in the seven path into the stretch but rally came up short. KENTUCKY JONES trailed early, was widest into the stretch then did not menace in the drive. POWER MOVE tracked the leaders while outside foes then tired into the stretch. GALLOPING BRIAR off the pace and trailing on the far turn, showed little.
