**Footnotes**

GREEN STORM had speed from the break and led the field into the turn, was inside and clear for the drive then kept to task in the final furlong. MR. MIELE made a good move on the turn after coming from off the pace, bid from the four path and finished willingly. GOLD STRIKE BEGINS inside early, angled out on the turn then finished well. GOLDEN HALL between foes and in the hunt, chased the speed, kept contact on the turn while inside entering the stretch then had a mild try. HEYWOODS tracked while between foes, was in the chase into the stretch then lacked a finish. FIRST RATE kept in touch, was in the three path on the turn for home then lacked a rally. IMPLIED ODDS was well back early and never threatened. BOXING RING showed little in an off the pace effort. KNEBWORTH was steadied while inside and in tight into the turn then faded. CANADIAN CHANCE veered out at the break, settled outside foes and tracked then tired. The rider of KNEBWORTH lodged a claim of foul against FIRST RATE for alleged interference into the turn. After a review by the STEWARDS the claim was disallowed.
