SPIDER ROCK stalked the pace, closed five-wide late turn, bid upper stretch and drove to a short lead and held under steady pressure. MAJOR MARVEL set the pace, quickened late turn, was caught upper stretch and headed then finished gamely to the wire. D'S LEGEND STORM forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then evened out. SALTY LANGFUHRN, off slowly, raced well back early, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then finished gamely. NEW BELIEVER raced off the pace, came three to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. CLASSICAL MELODY, rated off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was hustled into the stretch then evened out. LEGAL REVIEW raced midpack, was hustled on the turn but tired in the stretch. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START CONCERNING SALTY LANGFUHRN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
