CHARMING THUNDER settled off the pace, closed along the rail late turn, rallied gamely and got up in time, driving. CAP THAT pressed the pace from midway of the backstretch, bid into the turn, drew clear, widened leaving the turn then was tiring and failed to hold in deep stretch. HATHAWAY raced in midpack between foes, chased three-wide late turn and finished all out. PROPER HEIRESS stalked the pace from the rail, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. CORAL SANDS raced in midpack, chased four-wide between foes, finished gamely but was not a threat. WHAT SAY YOU settled off the pace, closed late turn, swung wide for the stretch drive, was all out but failed to menace. MALIBU LADY led onto the main track, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. LARGO VERDE showed brief speed, was headed entering the main track and stalked the pace, chased five-wide late turn but tired in the stretch. LOVELY LO settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. FOXY DEVIL broke awkwardly, raced in midpack from the second path then lacked a closing response. EMCEE RUSH broke in the air, raced well off the pace and lacked a closing response.
