JENNA'S WABBIT sprinted to the early lead, set a reserved pace then held sway under a drive. INCREDICAT broke sharply but was quickly passed, stalked the pacesetter, chased late turn and finished gamely. BEAR AND ROD raced in midpack, was hustled into the stretch and finished gamely in vain. NO EXCHANGES settled off the pace, was roused early turn, chased into the stretch but was not a threat. MR. MONTY was hustled early to stalk the pace, chased three-wide late turn then evened out in the late stages. FASTESTWHOGETSPAID, off a step slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response.
