FIFTH OVERTURE raced prominently and held a short lead late backstretch and turn, shook clear late turn then held sway under a drive. DEPUTY CURES BLUES vied early, forced the issue on the turn, launched an all out bid upper stretch but failed to get up. EXPECT AN ANGEL, off a step slowly, closed gradually along the rail through the turn then hung in the late stages. WEST BEWARE raced forwardly on the backstretch, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. SPANISH DECREE, well back early, was hustled along between horses through the turn then lacked a rally. LA TRILLIUM, rated off the pace, closed three-deep late turn then angled out at the top of the stretch but lacked a response. ROMAN ROMANCE showed brief speed, chased four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. ELUSIVE A. C. from raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide through the turn but lacked a late response.
