AIR WOLF raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, bid midstretch, dueled gamely and prevailed under a drive. FOXY LION raced in the middle of the pack, chased three to five-wide late turn, bid upper stretch and gained command, was engaged and dueled from midstretch but was outfinished. LORD OF GREATNESS, in touch, closed four-wide late turn, bid at the top of the stretch and moved clear briefly then gave way grudgingly. SEAL TEAM, off a step slowly, raced well back, posted a steady gain through the turn and was still running through the stretch but was too late to be a threat. NATIVE MANDATE raced midpack, was hustled four to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but flattened out with a sixteenth to run. SEISMOLOGIST led early, set a reserved pace, was collared late turn and tired. SKY TAPS raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. BOLD BANDIT stalked the pace, closed late turn, launched a determined but brief bid entering the stretch, was no match and tired.
