PHIL'S DREAM, in range, chased four-wide and bid late turn, had command at the top of the stretch then held sway under a hand ride. THE BULL GOT SHOT, in touch, was hustled three to five-wide through the turn and finished determinedly. SUNDERLAND raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide into the stretch and rallied gamely. CORBELLI raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide late turn, cut to the rail at the top of the stretch and rallied willingly. R PAINTED PAYNE raced midpack, chased hard two to four-wide on the turn but failed to menace. BOW BELL REEF, in touch between rivals, chased on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. DOC FROST was taken well off the early pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then rallied willingly but late. SMART EXECUTIVE stalked early, chased on the turn angling from three to six-wide then tired in the final furlong. FOREX TRADER, off slowly, raced off

the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn but did not threaten. MERCY STREET, in touch, was hustled up close along the through the the turn, chased hard to the stretch ready to tender his bid but was outkicked by the winner and tired. CALL TIME broke awkwardly, raced off the pace and was never a threat. QUID QUO PATROL broke sharply but outward and dashed to the lead, was swarmed midturn and tired. BEST OF JOHN stalked early, closed up and forced the pace on the turn, dueled from midturn, was headed late turn, chased briefly and tired in the stretch. FOREST FOUNTAIN raced off the pace, was hustled late turn then tired in the stretch.
