BEAR IT'S TIME, in touch, launched her rally early on the far turn, was all out through the stretch and was up just in time. NIIGON'S TOUCH stalked the pace, bid two-wide late turn, dueled, bested SPOOKY KITTEN in deep stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. SPOOKY KITTEN, prominent throughout, held a short lead on the backstretch, dueled through the far turn then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. MARKETING MIX stalked the pace, chased in earnest from the 1/4 pole and finished gamely in vain. PLEASANTFRIDAY held a narrow early lead, forced the issue on the backstretch, challenged late backstretch and dueled to late turn, was headed and chased stubbornly through the stretch. AMERICAN PLACED broke outward, settled off the pace, was hustled from early on the far turn but lacked a closing response.
