Footnotes

GUISEPPE raced off the pace, closed along the rail late turn, was blocked upper stretch, angled out, rallied gamely and just got up. SHOW THE WAY raced midpack, gained contention late turn, launched his rally at the top of the stretch, split foes midstretch and took command but failed to contain the winner in the final strides. GALLOPING BRIAR raced midpack, was hustled along the late turn, angled out upper stretch and finished determinedly. ALWAYS PRINCE, prominent early, settled and stalked the pace, failed to get up with an all out bid upper stretch and flattened out. HILLSWICK dueled from mid backstretch, gained a short lead upper stretch but yielded just into the final furlong. BRUNELLESCHI, well back early, was roused late turn, angled out upper stretch, rallied but did not threaten. DE CHERA raced off the pace, was hustled into the stretch but lacked a strong late response. NOT FOR ROYALS bid midway of the backstretch, dueled, yielded upper stretch and tired. HIGH PLATEAU pulled early and raced prominently three-wide, gave way at the top of the stretch and tired. KOVALCHUK raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but lacked a strong closing response. GIANT CONNECTION, well back early, saved ground, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. LONGLASTING raced off the pace between foes, was hustled along the rail late turn then tired in the stretch. ESSENCE THUNDER was steadied leaving, closed quickly between horses on the backstretch, chased hard late turn and tired.
