SIGNATURE RED moved up to force the issue early turn, bid upper stretch, dueled to the end and prevailed under a drive. HEROS REWARD was hustled to a short early lead, set a pressured pace, was engaged upper stretch, dueled to the end and gave way grudgingly. JUNGLE WAVE raced midpack, moved up and stalked from the rail on the turn then rallied gamely and was gaining late. FIELD COMMISSION raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn, launched an all out stretch drive and gained steadily. NOT BOURBON stalked from the outside, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. DR LARGE raced off the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch, showed a mild late run but did not menace. MAJOR MARVEL, up close early, was lugging out but got off the rail midturn, chased into the stretch then tired in the final furlong.
