FLIP FOR THE COIN, in range, closed late backstretch and bid outside the leaders into the far turn, dueled, was headed a little, rebid in the stretch and drove clear. JOEY'S BEST stalked the pace in hand, chased on the far turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. QUINZEE pressed the pace, dueled from early backstretch, was headed at the turn, rebid and had a short lead at the top of the stretch then gave way grudgingly. KEEP SIX led briefly then forced the pace on the backstretch, chased through the far turn but evened out in the late stages. NOT TOO TACKY raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch but never threatened. T. T.'S POINT raced off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the far turn then evened out midstretch. FLASHOFBRILLIANCE raced midpack, dropped back on the far turn then passed tiring horses in the stretch. HISAKI, in range early, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn but lacked a strong late response. SIR ADIE, up close early, stalked the pace but dropped back midway of the far turn. PEACE BAY stalked the pace, was shuffled back at the far turn, was hustled along the rail then tired in the stretch. GO IN PEACE, well back throughout, trailed on the far turn then lacked a rally.
