TUMERIC stalked the pace, chased on the turn, gained steadily and bid midstretch then prevailed under a drive. MAY FOURTEEN stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn, led briefly in the final furlong and gave way after a duel through the final 16th. FLASHY SURVIVOR raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then finished under a determined drive. JULIANSHOME settled off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn and finished gamely. BIG RED DADDY held a short lead midbackstretch, shook clear on the turn, was caught a furlong out and gave way. PICO PIKE was jostled early, settled off the pace and moved to the rail, angled off the rail late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch but was not a threat. MONO CLIFFS showed brief speed, was headed and stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn then evened out late. AINTNOFLYSONME settled off the pace, chased four-wide late turn, angled out approaching the stretch and failed to menace. WHO BY FIRE raced in midpack, was hustled late turn then

evened out in the stretch. DANISH SPIRIT raced in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then lacked a rally. GOTTANICERINGTOIT, in range, chased three and four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. ANOTHERCHICHYBABY pressed the pace, was roused through the turn but faded steadily.
