JINX BUSTER raced in midpack, closed three and four-wide on the far turn, rallied, bid midstretch and prevailed, driving. BEAR'S ACCOUNTANT, in touch, bid four-wide late turn, took command upper stretch, dashed clear then failed to contain the winner in the late stages. PEGU, off a step slowly, settled off the pace, chased five-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. FORESTERS PRIDE stalked the pace, bid three-wide midway of the far turn, dueled, but gave way at the top of the stretch and tired. CORPORATE HUSTLE settled off the pace, came four-wide through the far turn, chased hard into the stretch but did not threaten. HAWK CHASER raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn, was hustled but was steadied twice behind rivals then evened out in the

stretch. BOREAUS, in range, was hustled into the stretch then evened out. ON THIS ROCK raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, angled off the rail late turn but never reached contention. WIDMO, rated off the pace, closed on the far turn, angled out for the stretch but drive failed to menace. FARLEY WINK dueled, was headed briefly then rebid early turn, battled to the top of the stretch and tired. JUST RELAXING dueled, gained a short lead into the far turn, was engaged quickly, dueled once more then tired upper stretch. KILI raced off the pace, chased two-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. KEYBEST raced in midpack, chased hard on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
