ASGOODASITGETS was allowed to settle inside of rivals, roused three wide entering the stretch and prevailed under an all out drive. RUBY TANGO was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn, rallied four wide on the turn, continued strong in the drive and finished well just missing. DALIA'S WHIRL was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals while in the three path, then weakened in the late going. VITALINE showed good early speed and set a pressured pace well off the rail, dueled outside of DALIA'S WHIRL on the turn, then weakened in the drive. YOU'LL BE TRUE was unhurried early in the two path and never rallied. AWESOME DEED was void of early speed, never a factor and outrun. PYRITE MENU showed brief speed in the three path, then dropped back approaching the far turn.
