LAKE SECRET raced prominently along the rail, drove clear a furlong out and widened under a drive. GREAT ADDICTION, in touch, was hustled three-deep on the turn then finished evenly. DISBELIEF broke in the air, trailed along the rail, moved three-wide at the top of the stretch and gave a good late effort. BAD HAT, in touch, saved ground, closed late turn then evened out. WRITER'S WALK dueled to the final furlong and tired. TWISTED WIT stalked from between rivals, was roused late turn but had no response. CARRINGTON, close early, was hustled four-wide on the turn and tired.
