FUHREVER DANCING led early, set a reserved pace, held his rival at bay through the far turn and into the stretch and prevailed, driving. EXECUTIVE CHOICE pressed the pace, lapped on to the leader briefly at the half, chased hard through the far turn and into the stretch then tired with a sixteenth to run. CUBA, unhurried to the far turn, was hard ridden along the rail on the final turn and did not threaten. COLD WAR raced off the pace three-wide, was hustled through the far turn then evened out. BARRACUDA BOY checked up close behind horses moving into the first turn, remained in touch, was hustled on the far turn and tired. ARE YOU SERIOUS raced off the pace, was hustled into the far turn, tired, and was eased. LAKEVILLE RUSH stalked from the rail, tired midway of the far turn, faded quickly and was eased in the stretch.
