MONTY'S BEST, rated off the early pace, closed on the far turn, angled out late turn and bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, gained a narrow lead a furlong out, came in slightly and held SALTY LANGFUHN safe under a strong hand ride. SALTY LANGFUHN stalked the pace, moved to the fore late backstretch, dueled on the far turn, wore down his rival at the top of the stretch but was headed by the winner a furlong out and chased gamely to the end. TIGER BUD, rated off the pace, stalked on the far turn, chased into the stretch and launched an all out drive. BOOYAH, in range, chased three-wide late on the far turn but evened out in the stretch. BEARCATT raced off the pace, closed and angled out late on the far turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and evened out. STOLONBOY stalked to late on the backstretch then faded along the rail, was hustled into the stretch and evened out. KENNISIS RIVER led on the first turn, set a pressured pace, was joined late backstretch, dueled through the far turn and tired at the top of the stretch. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON SALTY LANGFUHN AGAINST MONTY'S BEST FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
