AYENDA, in touch early, took command early on the backstretch, set a reserved pace then was all out to hold in the late stages. MAXIMUM RIDE led briefly, was headed early backstretch and stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive, gained steadily and just missed. LIONS SUMMIT raced in midpack, stalked on the far turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. LA DONNA MOBILE stalked the pace, closed on the turn, loomed boldly at the top of the stretch but evened out late. ZDENKA settled off the pace, closed angling from three to five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. FLASHING HONOR settled off the pace, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch but failed to menace. SOUL SYMPHONY raced off the pace, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention.
