Footnotes

LEGAL HEIR was bumped at the start and dropped back, recovered quickly and allowed to settle mid pack outside of rivals, rallied four wide on the turn and assumed command in mid stretch, but bore out under left handed urging and bumped hard with MONTEZUMA'S GOLD in the final strides. The latter was allowed to settle just off the rail, waited patiently on the turn and was blocked in upper stretch, angled to the outside in mid stretch and closed willingly outside of LEGAL HEIR, but was bumped hard in the late going and outfinished. DON'T SEVEN OUT stumbled at the start and was allowed to settle inside of rivals, closed the gap entering the stretch, but was blocked until inside the final furlong, angled outside of a tiring SPRING BARLEY and got up for show. The latter broke sharply and set the early pace in hand, then gave way in upper stretch. BLADES HILL stalked the early pace three wide, closed the gap in upper stretch, but flattened out in the final strides. LEGAL JOUSTING (IRE) was allowed to settle between horses in the early going, angled out in upper stretch and finished with a mild rally. DIVINE LUCK was void of early speed four wide, continued off the rail on the turn and was never a threat. MILLER'S MARK was void of early speed just off the rail, moved five wide on the turn, but never rallied and was never a factor. EXPECTED COMMAND stalked the early pace in hand in the three path, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. FREE AGENT ON ICE showed little and was never a factor. There was a Stewards' inquiry following the race for possible interference in the drive, also the jockey of MONTEZUMA'S GOLD lodged a claim of foul against the jockey of LEGAL HEIR for possible interference at the same spot. After reviewing the tapes the Stewards ruled that LEGAL HEIR interfered with MONTEZUMA'S GOLD in the final strides and disqualified him from first and placed him second.
