Footnotes

BEST OF ALY, always in touch, chased hard four and five-wide on the turn, bid a furlong out and gained a short lead under a drive then was taken in hand near the wire. HONORS BEST showed brief speed, was headed and stalked the pace, regained the lead late turn, was engaged a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. SPANISH TREATY gained a short lead late backstretch, dueled into the turn, was passed late turn and evened out in the late stages. JUST FOR JANE raced midpack, was hustled six-wide late turn then finished gamely outside. HIGHS AND LOWS, in range, dueled into the turn, was passed late turn then evened out in deep stretch. CANADIAN LADY, in touch between horses, was roused five-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. GRACIOUS GLORIA raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response. FALCON FOREST gained a short early lead, was headed late backstretch and gave way gradually through the turn. LOPILATO, off slowly, raced off the pace and lacked a closing response. BELLA PARIS NOEL, off slowly, also raced off the pace and lacked a rally.
