MIGHTY MONARCH stalked pace the pace, bid into the far turn, dueled, shook clear upper stretch and finished under a hand ride. WHY DAT, well back early, chased two to five-wide on the far turn then rallied gamely outside. DEFINITE HUMOR showed brief speed and was taken back entering the first turn, stalked the pace, bid into the far turn, dueled, then yielded upper stretch and chased to the end. HISAKI, well back early, chased hard three and four-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. CALM NIGHT, in range, was hustled from the rail and two-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. GOLDY SONG hopped at the start, stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch. OUTFOTHEDEPTHS raced midpack, backed away on the far turn and lacked a rally. ALPHABET KID sprinted clear on the first turn, set the pace, was passed at the far turn and faded between foes.
