SIMPLY SMART raced in midpack, chased two and three-wide on the turn, rallied willingly and got by late under a light drive. AFTERNOON IDOL, steadied at the start, moved up quickly to duel, had the rail on the turn and shook clear at the top of the stretch, was all out but failed to hold the winner safe in the late stages. REIGNERS LANE stalked the pace, chased two-wide on the turn then rallied late between foes. GREEN FORESTER settled off the pace in hand, was hustled along the rail into the stretch and finished gamely. TRY RUNNING stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. FOREST FIGHTER raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. BE A BULL dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased to the final furlong and tired. ANGELIC MIA raced off the pace, was hustled hard four-wide through the turn then tired upper stretch.
