BEAR'S KITTY KITTY, prominent early, set a pressured pace then was all out to hold in the stretch. TWO WONDERS settled off the pace, closed late turn, rallied gamely and was gaining late. PLAYERS CLUB, away alertly and a bit outward, settled in midpack, chased hard three to five-wide on the turn then rallied outside. FUN IN D' SUN showed brief speed then settled in range, was hustled two-wide on the turn and finished gamely. STAGE TRIP forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. HOLY ACADEMY settled in midpack, chased four-wide late turn then flattened out midstretch. RINELLA BAY raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but lacked a closing response.
