Footnotes

COMMITTED stalked the pace, closed on the turn, bid upper stretch and gained a short lead, was joined a 16th out, dueled and prevailed under a drive. MOUNT DIABLO, away alertly, settled in range, chased four-wide late turn, bid midstretch but was outfinished. IT'S GOODTOBE DUKE forced the pace, took a brief run at the leader on the backstretch, rebid into the turn and took command, moved clear, was hustled along, was engaged upper stretch and gave way. WHERE'S THE BAY hit the gate leaving, settled in midpack, chased along the rail late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. HARDCASTLE led early, set the pace, turned back a rival on the backstretch but was headed early turn, chased to the stretch and tired. BOXOFFICE MATERIAL raced off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. SUNDAY SPARK broke inward, pulled along the rail on the backstretch, chased hard on the turn then tired in the stretch. BARE IS BEST raced off the pace, was hustled early turn but lacked a response and was through.
