Footnotes

HALIBURTON HONEY raced from off the pace in the early stages, closed along the rail late turn then rallied willingly through the stretch and got up in the final strides. ASHLEE'S BELLA stalked from between horses, chased late turn then gained steadily in the stretch, poked her nose in front in the late stages but missed. ROWAN EXPRESS (GB) led quickly, set a reserved pace then weakened in deep stretch. NUMEROUSASTHESTARS stalked from the rail, was hustled hard on the turn then evened out in the stretch. CLASSY FLOWER stalked three-wide, was four-wide late turn and tired in the stretch. CONQUISTADORDELITE, always well back, moved well off the rail midway through the backstretch, came four-wide through the turn then lacked a rally.
