DRIVING MS CHELSEA stalked the pace, closed late backstretch, took the lead entering the turn, turned back ENERGY RUSH upper stretch and widened under a drive. ENERGY RUSH set a pressured pace, was headed at the far turn, chased, then rebid along the rail at the top of the stretch but was no match. CHAN JA BANG raced midpack, was hustled three-wide through the far turn then evened out. CHRISTINE'S PRIZE, well back early, raced three-wide and finished gamely to no avail. FAR AND NEAR, always in touch, was hustled into the far turn, was roused late turn but evened out in the stretch. NUMEROUS LADY raced off the pace, saved ground, lacked a rally. MINSTREL MISS forced the pace, gave way late backstretch, chased on the turn and tired. LA GRAN DOMENIQUE was close early, came four-wide through the far turn and tired.
