QUENCH, well back early, closed three-deep on the turn, was all out closing in the stretch and just got up. MUSKWA was prominent early, vied into the turn, sprinted clear midturn, was all out through the stretch but failed to contain the winner at the wire. GREY BOUNDARY, well back early, closed four-wide on the turn then rallied willingly outside. STORM THE CASTLE raced forwardly early, was hustled three-wide on the turn but evened out in the stretch. PUDDLE STOMP raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the stretch. SMARTCARD gained a short lead late backstretch, vied into the turn, gave way midturn and tired. LONG FOR LIBERTY trailed four-wide, lacked a rally. CELERITY'S SUMMIT broke sharply but outward, raced forwardly on the backstretch then faded three-wide on the turn and tired.
