### Footnotes

TALE OF THE FOREST stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, responded to encouragement and gained steadily in the stretch and got by late finishing under a hand ride. BRAHMS BEAUTY held a short lead, moved clear on the turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. VICTORY ROMANCE pressed the pace, chased late turn then hung in the stretch. VENDETTA raced off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide through the turn but never threatened. ADVISABLE, off a step slowly, raced two and three-wide on the turn, was roused but lugged in through the stretch and did not threaten. NOT NO MORE stalked the pace, was trying to move off the rail, could not because of rivals to her outside and gave no response to rousing.
