Footnotes

ROVINA raced midpack, angled from two-wide to five-wide late turn, chased into the stretch, challenged a sixteenth out and drove clear. JOVIAL JILL was in touch early, bid late turn, vied into the stretch, drove clear briefly but failed to stave off the winner. SATIN SLIPPERS stalked the pace, angled four-wide late turn then was all out through the stretch. BAYWOODS stalked the pace, bid midturn, dueled into the stretch, yielded upper stretch and tired. SEASIDE VIEW settled well off the early pace, saved ground and tendered a mild rally in the stretch but was never a threat. REGAL PUSHER led quickly, set a pressured pace, yielded late turn and tired upper stretch. ALITTLEBITOFROUGE raced midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. WALZIN TO T MUSIC stalked to late on the backstretch and faded four-wide through the turn.
