BAR IS OPEN set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn, widened under an all out drive in the stretch then was under a hand ride nearing the wire. EXECUTIVE MANCER forced the pace, stalked on the turn, lost position at the top of the stretch, angled out and rallied determinedly. LEENANE'S LULLABY, in touch, angled inward from five to three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but was unable to gain late. SHARP ENOUGH chased in range, saved ground through the turn then finished evenly. BEAUTY PLUS, in touch, came five and six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out late. SAUGEEN MISS raced off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide late turn but was never a threat. DREAM PATROL was hustled from midpack but lacked a rally. TRAJECTORY ROSE raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the turn but was never in contention.
