Footnotes

MISS SWEEP drew even between horses and vied for the early lead, dueled inside of MAGGIE'S TURN through the turn, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. The latter made a quick move outside of rivals in the backstretch and drew even approaching the turn, dueled outside of the winner into the stretch, but could not stay with that one in the drive. MICAYLA'S PEACH was unhurried early off the rail, continued racing wide in the turn and closed the gap, but was never a threat. RETURN JOURNEY was hustled along inside of rivals, split horses in upper stretch and finished with a mild bid. MYSTERIOUS AMY broke sharply and vied for the early lead going four wide, then weakened in the stretch. BOLD AND WICKED was void of early speed and never rallied. KASHAGAWIGAMOG was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses, then tired. DEVILISH LADY was off slowly and never a factor. LADY HAZAAM pressed the early pace inside of rivals, steadied through the turn and bore out at the quarter pole and dropped back.
