JUDITHS WILD RUSH stalked three-wide, bid on the fourth path at the 1/4 pole, dueled into the stretch and edged clear under a drive a sixteenth out. HIGH BLITZ broke alertly, raced prominently three-wide, was headed in the stretch and was all out at the finish. MINISTERS WILD CAT showed speed between horses, dueled to the final furlong, gave way but finished gamely. MISTER COOP was unhurried early, advanced three-wide late turn then rallied widest. TWISTED WIT, in touch early, was hustled along the rail on the turn but flattened out in the stretch. SEEKING THE CARAT, well back early, raced along the second path, was set down midturn but did not threaten. MIKE'S CLASSIC reared at the start then moved up quickly to duel, was headed early turn and gave way gradually.
