SALTY SILVER SALLY took a short early lead, was joined midway of the backstretch and dueled with WILLOW BEACH, sprinted clear early on the far turn then held to the wire under a drive. MORNING PRAYERS, always in touch, angled out between foes through the far turn, chased and was gaining late. GRASS TANGO raced off the pace, angled out through the far turn and closed steadily in the stretch. LA NOVIA stalked the pace, was roused three-wide on the far turn, finished gamely and was best of the rest. FONA raced off the pace, saved ground, was hustled through the far turn then evened out. COUSIN PAM raced evenly while three and four-wide, never reached contention. ORBITAL RING, in touch early, was hustled along three-wide, lacked a rally. LUNE DE MIEL broke awkwardly, trailed the field, saved ground and passed tiring foes. WILLOW BEACH forced the pace, dueled from midbackstretch, was no match on the far turn and tired. TRUTH TAKES TIME, well back early, raced between foes, lacked a rally. FOREVER FRIENDS

was close early, raced four-wide throughout and faded on the far turn. SURVIVE THE STORM raced three and four-wide and showed little.
