WISEHER chased the speed with an inside trip, took on others in the drive, dueled to the wire and prevailed while full out. PLAYING FOR FUN on the inside early, angled out and was up on the pace into the far turn, bid three wide, vied to the wire while outside the winner and missed. DUBAI CALLING was hustled to the lead, held sway into the far turn, took on inside and outside challenges and gave way in the final furlong. STRIKING MISS had an inside trip, trailed early and then lacked a serious bid. RENAISSANCE GIRL tracked from between foes, was a factor on the far turn then had no finish. HARPOON HATTIE in mid pack early, raced off the pace on the far turn then did not threaten. TAKE IT AND GO showed little in an off the pace effort.
