PHINEAS in mid pack, gained ground on the turn, swung wide into the stretch then rallied four wide and proved best. VEZEAU BEACH off the pace and far back, was wide with plenty to do turning for home then fired down the lane and proved second best with an excellent stretch rally. KWIK COSTA had an inside trip, vied into the turn then led into the stretch only to be outfinished by rivals. YOU HAVE NO IDEA kept contact then bid three wide on the turn, was in the tussle into mid stretch then came up late. SOIR NOIR off the pace, gained and bid from the rail after and inside trip but did not have enough. SPEED THRILLS vied outside early then between foes on the turn before fading in the drive. HIP HIP SINHA was off the pace and did not fire. BEAR KIRIDASHI KID tracked the speed duel then failed to bid.
