BORJOMI, in range, closed four-wide late turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear. GOLD DREAMER led early, quickened on the turn, was collared a furlong out, was quickly headed and chased the winner home. MAXIOM, in range, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn and finished all out. FIERCE PROSPECT, in range, came two to five-wide through the turn, was roused and responded gamely but evened out late. SLEW THE MAESTRO, well back early, came two to five-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. TARAS RULER stalked the pace to midturn then faded despite encouragement. YO TAMBIEEN stalked the pace in hand, was hustled along the rail and two-wide on the turn then tired a furlong out. DON DIEGO was always well back and lacked a rally.
